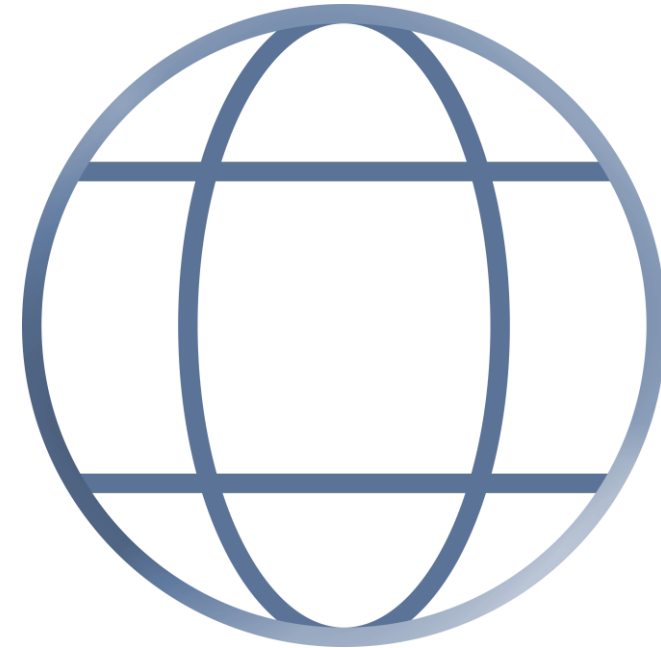


# Web

Build apps using same open-source Fluent UI components as Microsoft apps



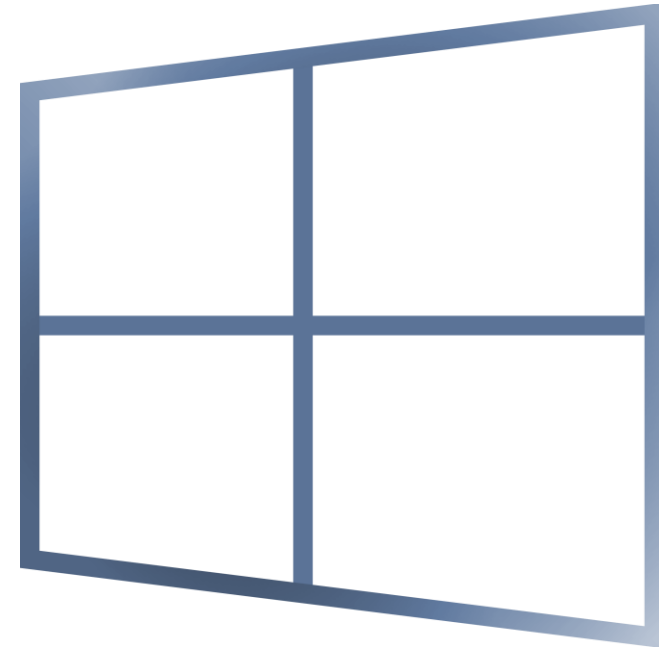

Fluent UI allows your iOS apps to use the same toolkits as Microsoft written in Swift

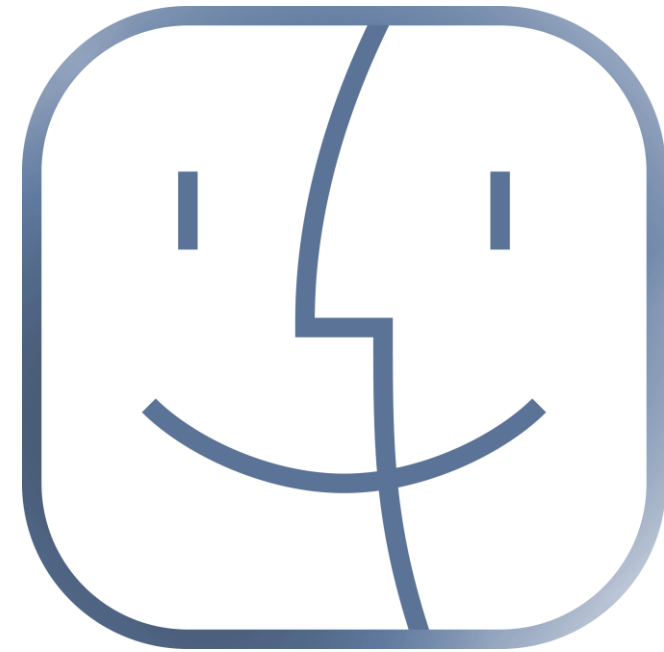


# macOS

Fluent UI is a native library used by Microsoft 365 apps with controls written in Kotlin



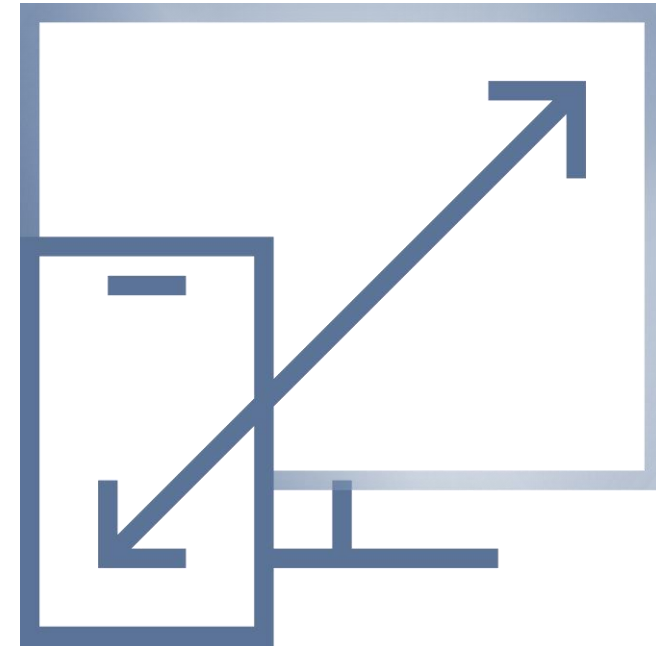
